WA SQUASH GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A player is to be deemed eligible for entry in a particular age group if the player has not turned that age by the last day of the event.
2. Age groups are to be known as U11, U13, U15, U17 and U19.
3. The Championships will be conducted using a recognised tournament management system.
4. All games will be the best of five games using PAR 11 scoring.
5. The Dunlop double yellow dot ball will be used for all events.
6. All draws are seeded by the Tournament Organising Committee. The seeded players will have draw positions allocated. The remaining players will be drawn randomly.
7. Protective eyewear that complies with Squash Australia policy is compulsory for all players competing in the championships and must be worn whenever a player is on court.
8. Players must report to the tournament control desk 30 minutes prior to the scheduled match time.
9. Players are required to mark/referee the match before or after their match as directed by the Tournament Director or Tournament Referee.
10. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the full entry fee.
11. No late entries will be accepted.
12. The Tournament Organisers (WA Squash and their officers, employees or agents) shall not be liable for any death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property sustained or incurred by any person in connection with these championships however caused.
13. The Tournament Director reserves the right to:
 - a. accept or refuse any entry
 - b. disqualify any player for late arrival or misconduct
 - c. combine events
 - d. alter match times
 - e. vary conditions of play
14. All players must be available to play between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Saturday & Sunday.

WA SQUASH TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

Players entering the tournament agree to:

1. Refrain from any conduct which would bring the sport into disrepute.
2. Abide by the spirit as well as the letter of the Rules of Squash.
3. Abide by the Regulations and Policies of Squash Australia see www.squash.org.au for regulations and policies.
4. Comply with the reasonable directions of tournament officials.
5. No alcohol is to be consumed by any Junior.
6. Irrespective of age, not consume any prohibited drugs. Any player found to be under the influence of any prohibited drug during the course of the tournament will be in breach of these conditions.
7. Participate in any random drug testing conducted by the appropriate authority.
8. The player is to be registered and insured member with their Club/State or country of origin.
9. Eyewear is compulsory for all juniors, under the age of 19.

I agree to comply with the Tournament conditions as set out in this entry form.

By signing this entry form I/we accept the conditions of entry as outlined above.

I/we acknowledge that any breach of these conditions will render me/my child liable for suspension for the remainder of the tournament and banned from attending any premises associated with the tournament.

I/we understand the Tournament Organising Committee will decide on any suspension in relation to the WA Squash tournament conditions. Any appeal against a decision of the Tournament Organising Committee will be referred to the General Manager of WA Squash.

I/we understand WA Squash may invite the Club/State/Territory association of any suspended player to consider any further sanctions against an offending player.

I/we understand the Tournament Entry Fees will not be refunded to any suspended player.

I/we give permission to WA Squash to use any photographic image taken of me at this event to be used by WA Squash in printed publications on the internet or in other electronic formats.
