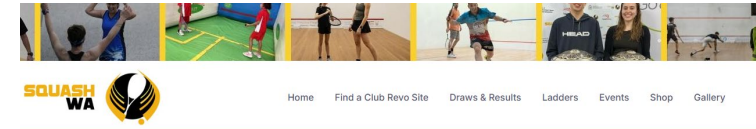

Discussion Points

Junior Pathway

- 18 months ago, we started an invitational talent squad of around 30 juniors. Roughly 20 training sessions per year.
- 2024 Australian Junior Championships performance wasn't great compared to other states.
- Late last year, assessed the program with our Level 2 and 3 coaches with the following implemented as a result:
 - * Three smaller groups instead of one large group according to ability.
 - * Higher coach to junior ratio.
- Involvement of country kids as much as is practical for them.
- All these changes mean more work! Josh Blakey has joined the team as Junior Development Officer to run all things junior and school related. Josh will be in contact with Metro and Country Junior Coordinators soon to see how things are going.
- Most metro junior programs have started off with a bang, with many reporting numbers higher than they've had for several years.

Education Pathway

- We will be pushing coaching and refereeing certification and course attendance.
- Apprentice stage added to these pathways.
- We NEED to increase both the number of coaches and referees in order for our sport to grow and prosper.
- Increased focus on upskilling our older juniors, but anyone is welcome and encouraged to become involved.
- Level 1 Referee certification sessions are set for Saturday 26 April and Sunday 15 June, both at the State Squash Centre from 9.30am to 1.30pm. Register via Revo for \$30 and have this refunded once you provide evidence of your Level 1 certification to the office.

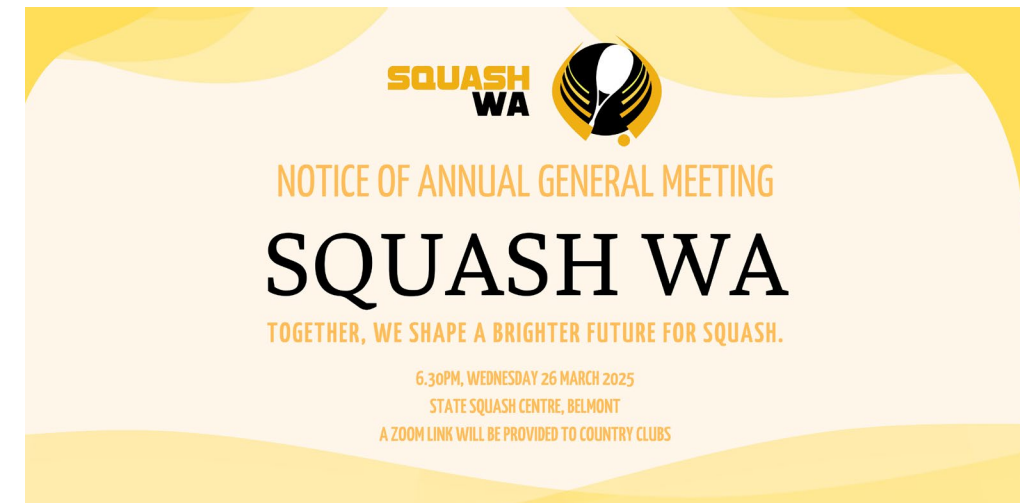

Annual General Meeting

- Notice of AGM has been sent out.
- Arrive at 6.15pm for a 6.30pm SHARP start, Wed 26 March.
- Minimum 1 representative from every Club must attend.
- A couple of items require a vote and it's important to understand what you're voting for.
- Metro Clubs urged to attend in person where possible. Online option for Country Clubs.
- Bar open, nibbles provided.
- Further documentation including the Annual Report to be sent out on 26 February (next week).



Discussion Points

AGM

- New membership model is ready to take effect. Lawyers have reviewed our constitution and advised that we are able to go ahead without amending it. The new club will need to be voted in but will not have voting rights.
- Changing our year from calendar to financial (Jul-Jun).
- Three Board positions up for re-election. Clubs will need to vote.
- Documentation to be sent out on 26 February including Annual Report, Board Nomination forms (updated to ask more questions), financial statements and more.
- A few other constitution changes that will need to be voted on.
- All affiliated clubs to have representation. No proxies will be allowed. Can be any Club member, not just Committee Members or Presidents.

Running Tournaments

- Uniformity in how we run tournaments is beneficial for all.
- Squash WA have developed a 'Tournament Pack' for clubs to utilise.
- Includes templates for budget, tournament kit, canteen requirements, presentations, prize money allocation and more.

Tournament Timeline

Action

6 MONTHS PRIOR

Set up tournament online once confirmed, request sanctioning.

Ensure Squash WA tournament T&Cs are included in the software.

If a PSA tournament, register on PSA website.

Engage a planning committee if a function will be incorporated in the event.

Engage a canteen coordinator if there are facilities on site to run the event.

Create a Save the Date flyer and distribute to Clubs, via social media.

Set up a QR code for quick and easy registration. Add to flyers and website.

Organise sponsors/supporters. Acquire their logos for all marketing.

Book the courts and ensure centre operator is on board.

Set up an Event Summary and Budget.

Ensure tournament is added to the SWAN.

3 MONTHS PRIOR

Open registration for tournament sign up.

Liaise with planning committee to ensure all requirements are met.

Update flyer with any additional special requirements.

Re-circulate flyer via email and social media.

Send flyer to SWAN for inclusion in the directory.

Overseas Players

- Players from overseas may ask you for a letter of support or invitation. These are usually not genuine.
- Squash WA does not provide invitation letters or letters of support to overseas or interstate players.
- Clubs are also asked not to provide these.
- Invitation/support letters are for Professional Squash Association (PSA) tournaments only, and must be obtained directly from the PSA office via written request: office@psaworldtour.com.
- Pass this onto anyone who asks you for one.



Discussion Points

Running Tournaments

- With Revo here, it's the perfect opportunity to get as many clubs following a uniformed set up when running tournaments.
- We have created a complete guide for clubs to use which includes timeline (what to do 6 months prior, 3 months, etc.), budget template, prize money breakdown calculator, run sheet for presentations, and much more. - We acknowledge the calendar is looking very full which is brilliant for our sport.
- We are getting to the point where there will be more than one tournament on some weekends.

Upcoming Tournaments

- Australian Masters Championships in September this year. Please push and promote. This event usually attracts around 400+ players from around the country.
- Squash WA are fighting to get the World Masters Championships here in 2026 which attracts upwards of 1,000+ competitors.

THIS MEMBERSHIP MODEL FOR INDIVIDUALS HAS BEEN CREATED TO CAPTURE INVOLVEMENT IN THE SPORT ACROSS 5 CATEGORIES:

COMPETE

Membership for senior and junior players that compete at all levels of the game, eg. international, PSA, national, state and local. With this membership, players are issued with a competition license that enables participation in competitions at all levels of the game. Membership also entitles the player to a Squash Australia ranking, including an AJST (Australian Junior Squash Tour) ranking for junior players.

LOCAL

Membership for senior and junior players that play at the local level of the game, eg. club pennants, league, in-house, Masters, etc. With this membership, players are issued with a competition license that enables participation in local competitions. Membership also entitles the player to a Squash Australia ranking.

LIFESTYLE

Membership for senior and junior players that play on a casual/recreational basis but not in any organised competitions.

SUPPORT

Membership for those who don't actively play squash but are involved in other capacities in the game, eg. coach, referee, committee member, volunteer, club administrator, parent, etc.

DIGITAL

Membership for supporters of the game that don't actively participate in any capacity, but want to stay informed with all the latest news and information.
